Holy Week Schedule

Holy Week is the time when we walk with Jesus from the excitement of the Palm Procession and Last Supper to the anguish in the Garden of Gethsemane and the desolation of the Cross before arriving at the joy of the Resurrection.

April 13 10:30 am ~ Palm / Passion Sunday - The service begins with the Liturgy of the Palms as we remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. People are invited to process around the church waving palms as we sing "All Glory, Laud and Honour". We then tell the story of the Passion of Christ.

April 17: 7:00 pm ~ Maundy Thursday - This service recalls the events of the night before Jesus died. We begin with foot-washing and then move to the Institution of the Last Supper. At the end of the service we strip the altar and those who wish are invited to pray quietly in the church for one hour. We close with an Order of Compline and exit the church in silence.

April 18: 11:00 am ~ Good Friday - On Good Friday, the most solemn day of the church year, we assemble to remember the Passion of Our Lord as we journey with Jesus to His Crucifixion. We exit the church in silence.

April 19: 7:00 pm ~ Holy Saturday - This service begins outdoors (west door) with the lighting of the new fire. The Pascal candle is lit from the new fire and carried into the church.

April 20: 10:30 am ~ Easter Day - This is the day we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord. Butterflies and Alleluias are unleashed and chocolate Easter eggs are waiting to be found.
